- 7. The Library reserves the right to omit entries it feels are not appropriate for public viewing.
- 8. The Library is not responsible for any damage to dioramas.
- 9. Please limit the amount of food items (except Peeps) in your entry.
- 10. All characters must be portrayed by Peeps (no other figurines).
- 11. Dioramas will be on display in the Library from March 31-April 6. Please pick up your diorama by April 8. If the diorama is not picked up by Monday, April 10 the Library will dispose of it.
- 12. Peeps contest will be judged by Library staff. The Peeple's Choice award will be determined by public voting during the display period (March 31- April 6). The winners of each age category and the Peeple's Choice award will be announced online and notified by phone on April 7, 2023. Winners will receive a prize that can be picked up at the Library on April 7, 2023.
